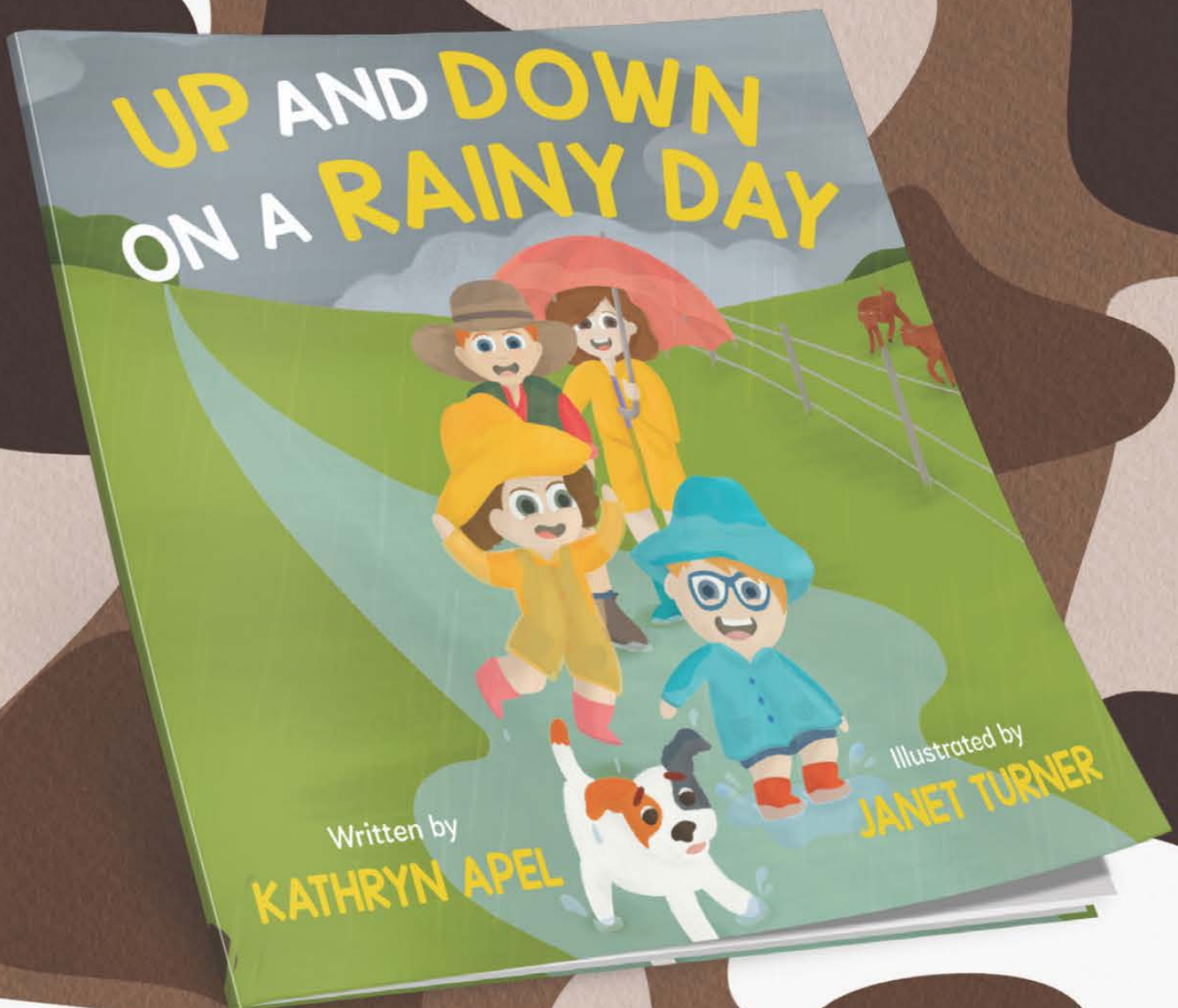

Follow the Trail, Read a Tale, Have an Adventure!

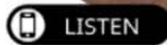
Enjoy reading outdoors with your family.

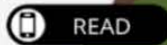

Match the causes on the left with the effects on the right. Connect the pictures by drawing a line. Get an adult to help you.



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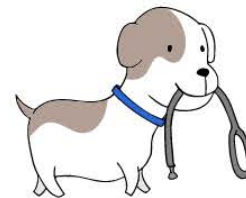

Old MacDonald Had a Farm

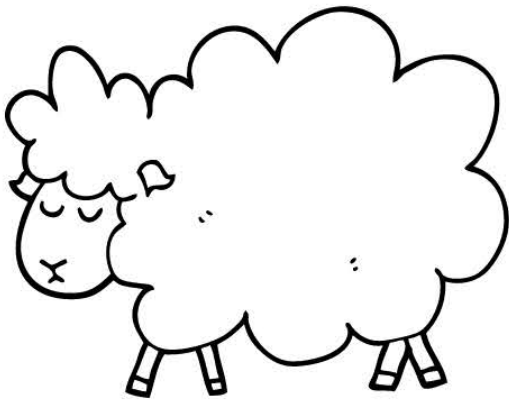
Old MacDonald had a farm,

E-I-E-I-O.



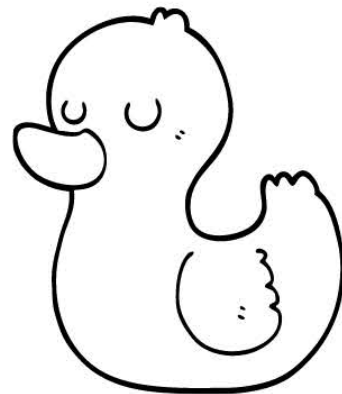

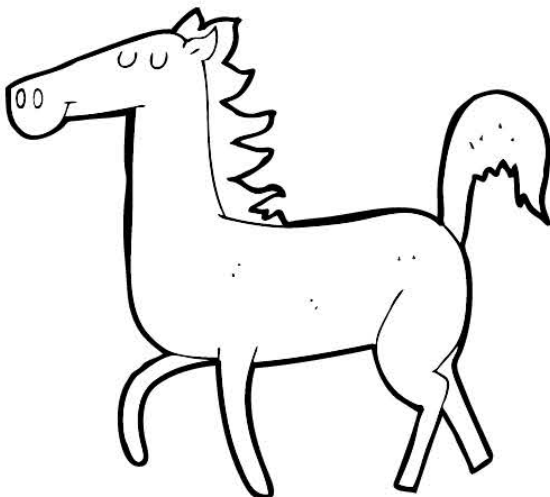

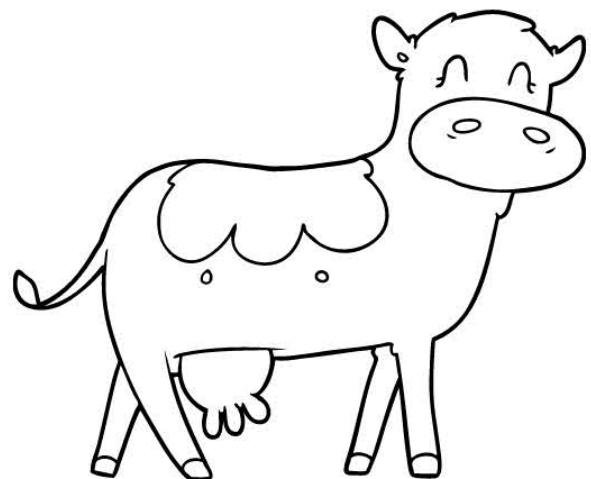
